Summary

The testament dative and inventory of the movable estate, money and debts pertaining to the deceased William Dryisdaill in Schirdaill, within the parish of Dollar and sheriffdom of Clackmannan, at the time of his death, who dies on 14 January 1600, faithfully made an given up by Alexander Dryisdaill in Forrest, his brother, on behalf of William, Symon, Johne, Jonet, Ewffame, Agnes and Cristiane Dryisdaill, lawful children to the deceased and executors dative to their late father, as described in a decreet of 14 February 1600.

<u>Inventory</u>

William Dryisdaill in Schirdaill had the following movable goods, sums of money and debts at the time of his death:

- 4 oxen, 64 pounds
- 2 young oxen, 40 merks
- 3 stots (2 year old), 21 pounds
- 6 cows with calves, 72 pounds
- 2 cows (2 year old), 48 pounds
- 27 ewes and young sheep, 54 pounds
- In the barn and barnyard, 60 bolls of oats, valued with the fodder at 300 pounds
- 8 bolls of barley, valued with the fodder at 48 pounds
- Equipment and household contents, with body clothes and personal possessions, estimated as 14 pounds

Total of the inventory – 660 pounds



Debts owed to the deceased

By George Dryisdaill, portioner of Balhartie, 5 pounds 6 shillings 8 pence

Total of the inventory and debts - 666 pounds 6 shillings and 8 pence

Debts owed by the deceased

- To Lord Argyle, his master, for his year's rent for 1600, 9 pounds 6 shillings 8 pence
- To Peter Horne, servant, for his fee for 1600, 3 pounds 6 shillings 8 pence
- To Johne Dryisdaill, servant, for his fee for 1600, 20 shillings

Total of the debts owed by the deceased – 14 pounds 13 shillings 4 pence

Remaining movable estate – 670 pounds 13 shillings 4 pence To be divided in 3 parts, of which the deid's part is 246 pounds 6 shillings 8 pence Quot [court's fee] 7 pounds

Mr John Nicolsoun of Edinburgh Commissary Court confirmed the said William, Symon, Johne, Jonet, Ewffame, Agnes and Cristiane Dryisdaill as executors dative to the deceased Willim Dryisdaill, their father, and Hew Mekiljohne, smith burgess of Edinburgh became cautioner.
